

Groundbreaking ceremonies were held July 7, 2010 for Phase 1 of the Town of Bluffton's Buck Island-Simmons ville Sewer Project. The Town was awarded \$500,000 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds in July 2008 to extend sewer service to residents along a portion of Buck Island Road, Centerfield Lane, Ballfield Road, Browns Way, Twin Oaks, Hyon and Tower Road. Total project cost will be approximately \$1,813,942. Remaining funds will come from Beaufort Jasper Water Sewer Authority (BJWSA) and Beaufort County School District. This project will benefit approximately 276 residents of which 85% are considered low-to-moderate income. Lowcountry Council Governments' Community & Economic Development Department administers the grant project.
