Lowcountry Regional HOME Consortium recently awarded \$100,000 to LowCountry Habitat for Humanity as partial funding for materials to construct four single-family homes on St. Helena Island.

The homes will be funded through donations and built by local and visiting volunteers. Habitat requires that families meet its qualifying criteria including ability to fulfill sweat equity hours. Mortgages are paid to Habitat, and families must show ability to pay based on monthly income.

Community leaders and Habitat guests and staff gathered at the site on June 17, 2010 for a groundbreaking ceremony.
